# **Program Overview**

With 35 established medical programmes in Malaysia and 3,000 medical students graduating annually, there is a strong need to ensure that medical graduates are work ready by the time they leave their alma mater. Work readiness is not just equipping students with the tools of trade but also involves appropriate assessment to ensure that they can successfully assimilate and integrate into the clinical workplace.

This one and a half day conference targets work readiness amongst medical students with focus on professionalism issues, patient safety, student resilience and mental wellbeing. It is delivered by experienced local and international academics through a series of keynote lectures, plenaries, interactive forum and workshops.
